WELCOME TO PRINCE OF PEACE LUTHERAN CHURCH

OUR BASIC BELIEFS

We are a congregation of the Evangelical Lutheran Church in America (ELCA), which is a mainline Protestant denomination of 4-million members. Our roots are in America, but originate from immigrant populations in Germany and Northern Europe.

We have developed most of our core beliefs from the teachings of Martin Luther and the reformers of the 16th century. Central to those beliefs is the unmerited grace of God that comes to us in the person of Jesus Christ. We believe that we are not saved by what we do but by the love, mercy, and forgiveness given to us in Jesus Christ. We believe that Jesus teaches us, his disciples, just how much God loves us; and because we are so loved, we can love others as well.

We don't believe that we have all the answers, but rather, lots of questions! We want to know the best ways to show God's love in this world and how to live a life of service, already having received the promises of God.

Historically, the Lutheran Church has shown a great respect for the liturgy and hymnody of the church. Our church gathers around God's Word and the Sacrament of Christ's body and blood each week and then is sent out into the world to serve.

Prince of Peace strives to be an inviting, diverse, and Christ-centered community. **We welcome all people regardless of race, ethnic background, gender, sexual orientation, or economic condition in life.**

WORSHIP SERVICES

All of our worship services use a traditional liturgical setting. Holy Communion is celebrated weekly at each of our Saturday and Sunday services.

The 5:30 pm service and the 8:15 am service tend to be smaller gatherings averaging 50-60 people. The larger worship services are on Sundays at 9:30 and 11:00 am.

The Prince of Peace Choir sings mostly at the 11:00 am service. Soloists, ensembles and instrumentalists offer music at the other times.

SUNDAY SCHOOL

Classes are offered for all – ages 3 through adulthood. We use Augsburg's *Sparks Activate Faith* and *Whirl* curriculums for our younger children. We offer a Sunday morning Confirmation program for our middle schoolers, grades 6, 7, and 8. We hold a Bible study and current events discussion for our high school students and adults.

NURSERY

We offer a staffed nursery on Sunday mornings. Staff members are trained in the care of infants and children, and are assisted by parent volunteers. All staff members have been trained in First Aid and CPR. We use a parent pager system in case parents need to be contacted during worship. All children must be signed into and out of the nursery. Each child's safety and comfort are our primary concerns.

CHOIRS AND MUSIC

Prince of Peace is blessed with many gifted vocalists and instrumentalists. You will see and hear their gifts during worship services and at various musical events throughout the year.

YOUTH MINISTRY

At both baptism and confirmation, our congregation makes a commitment to support the faith journey of our children. To fulfill that promise, much of our ministry intentionally focuses on our youth.

Christian education is at the heart of our youth program with weekly Sunday School for all ages at 9:30 am on Sundays.

Our confirmation program for middle school students offers classes on Sunday mornings, Wednesday evenings, and occasionally on Saturdays. This allows our busy families to choose the class times that best fit their schedules

We have three youth groups which strive to balance educational opportunities, fellowship, fun, and outreach during their gatherings.

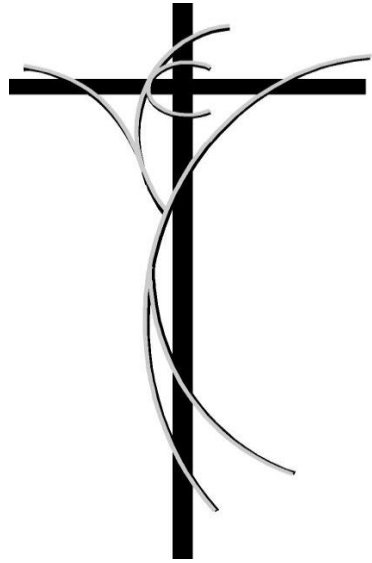
